## Details of the Amendments to ByLaws proposed by the Executive Committee for consideration and approval of the Special General Body.

1.	<b>II. Rules and Regulations</b> <b>1)Membership</b> Membership application format – Page-4 Appendix-I	<b>Revised Application Format – Appendix-I Attached</b>	Simplified and compact format introduced for convenience.
2.	<b>Page No.9, Sl.No.8(a) Administration:</b>  The administration and management of the Association shall vest with the Executive Committee. The term of the elected members of the Executive Committee shall be three years.	<b>Term of the Executive Committee</b>  The administration and management of the Association shall vest with the Executive Committee. The term of the elected members of the Executive Committee shall be five years from the date of assuming the office.  This will come into effect from the date of approval in the Special General Body meeting and this Five Year term is applicable to the present executive committee.	The term extended as per the decision of AGM held on 29-3-2025.  This is in conformity with Karnataka Societies Registration Act 1960 and Karnataka Co-operative Societies Act – 1959.
3.	<b>Page No.9, Sl.No.8(a)</b>  <b>Co-opted Members :</b>  The Executive Committee in its meeting shall co-opt five life members from among those members who have not contested for the preceding election of the Association, for a three year term which in its opinion will be useful to the Executive Committee in the discharge of its duties and functions. They shall have the voting rights in the Executive Committee.	<b>Co-opted Members:</b>  The Executive Committee in its meeting shall co-opt five life members from among those members who have not contested for the preceding election of the Association, for a Five Year term which in its opinion will be useful to the Executive Committee and Alumni Association in the discharge of its duties and functions. While co-opting members, care shall be taken to co-opt Life Members of Alumni Association, UAS(B), who represent different areas like Progressive Farmers, Banking, Agri. Graduate Farmers, Agri Entrepreneurs, Education Field, Central Government Organizations, State Government Organizations, NGO's, FPO's and other areas.

	<p>Both the elected and co-opted members only shall have the voting rights in the Executive Committee.</p> <p>In the event of resignation of an Executive Committee member, the Executive Committee shall take the candidate who has secured the next highest number of votes than the one elected member of the Executive Committee at the 15<sup>th</sup> place.</p>	<p>The process of co-option shall be initiated and completed as and when the requirement of co-opted members arise and shall be decided by the Executive Committee within six months. If the Executive Committee could not come to conclusion in selecting the alumni members for co-option, the office bearers have the discretion to nominate the members.</p> <p>Both the elected and the co-opted members shall have the voting rights in the general decisions of the Executive Committee.</p> <p>In case of voting for election or removal of any office bearer/s (on the grounds of No Confidence Motion), only the elected members shall have the voting rights.</p> <p>In the event of arising of vacancies of elected EC members due to resignation / removal / death etc., the Executive Committee shall take the candidate/s who have secured the next highest number of votes than the one elected member of the EC at 15<sup>th</sup> place.</p> <p>In the event of unanimous selection of the Executive Committee, the vacancy shall be filled up by the Executive Committee with the consent of the President for the remaining term following the guidelines for co-option.</p>

No. 3</b></p> <p>Not mentioned</p>	<p><b>Removal / Discontinuation of Office Bearers / Executive Committee Members (Not mentioned)</b></p> <p>No confidence motion against Executive Committee member / office bearer can be brought before Executive Committee if the motion is supported by at least 50% of the EC members, furnishing the reasons for no confidence against the person.</p>	<p>The Bylaws does not provide direct reference. Submitted for better clarity and avoid disputes / litigation.</p>

		<p>The explanation letter shall be served to the person against whom the No Confidence motion is submitted, calling for his/her reply to the allegations made against him/her giving 30 days time. After receiving the explanation letter, the Secretary shall call EC meeting within 30 days from the date of receiving the explanation letter from the person against whom No Confidence motion is submitted. The reply shall be placed before the EC and the person shall be removed from the committee or office, if majority of the members vote and reject the explanation submitted. If the reply is not submitted within 30 days, then the office bearer will be automatically removed. If the votes polled are equal, the President will have a casting vote. The office bearers who have been removed shall continue as EC member.</p>	
5.	<p><b>III. Bylaws</b> 2) Removal of Members by Resignation</p>	<p>Any life member who wishes to resign and submits resignation letter shall be approved by the Executive Committee. If the member has not withdrawn his/her resignation letter within 30 days from the date of resignation letter, it is deemed to have been accepted.</p>	<p>To have time bound effect.</p>
6.	<p><b>III. BYLAWS – Page No. 18 5(d)</b> Expenditure up to Rs. One Lakh per item may be incurred with the approval of the Executive Committee. Expenditure exceeding Rs. One Lakh per item should be got approved by the General Body. However, in emergent cases, expenditure can be incurred after approval by the Executive Committee and should be got ratified by the General Body.</p>	<p>Expenditure up to <b>Rs. Five Lakhs</b> per item may be incurred with the approval of the Executive Committee. Expenditure exceeding <b>Rs. Five Lakhs</b> per item shall be approved by the General Body. However, in emergent cases, expenditure can be incurred after approval by the Executive Committee and shall be ratified by the General Body.</p>	<p>The limit has not been revised since 20 years. In view of cost escalation, the new limit has been requested for approval by the General Body.</p>
